Campsite "Camp66" cat **** in Ścięgny is located near the border with the Czech Republic and Germany, in the middle of Europe, in Lower Silesia, in the Karkonosze district, near Karpacz, at the foot of the Sudetes.

According to ACSI, campsite no. 66 Sciegny was recognized in 2024 as the best campsite in Poland and one of the best in the whole Europe.

Thanks to the mountainous, green landscape with 90 km of hiking trails, the area is ideal for active recreation. Jelenia Góra, the capital of the Karkonosze district, is an attractive city with numerous architectural monuments, palaces, parks and many other tourist attractions, eagerly visited by tourists.

Karpacz and its surroundings is one of the most interesting parts of Poland.

In Karpacz, it is worth seeing, among others, the wooden Wang Church, the dam on Łomnica, the toy museum. Karpacz is also a great starting point for hiking trips to Śnieżka and the Karkonosze Mountains.

In Kowary, next to Karpacz, there is the Lower Silesia Monuments Miniature Park, where you can see many Lower Silesian palaces in miniature, including Czocha Castle.
